Julie Magno Zito is Associate Professor of Pharmacy and Medicine at the Pharmaceutical Health Services Research Department, University of Maryland, School of Pharmacy. Her major research interests are psychopharmacology; pharmacoepidemiologic methods for assessing the effectiveness and safety of marketed medications for the treatment of mental disorders; relationships between drug usage and treatment outcome; psychosocial factors influencing the prescribing of medications for the management of chronic behavioral disorders e.g. competency, institutionalization, patient refusal.
